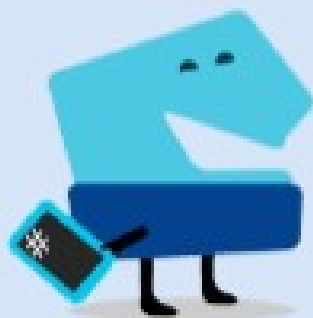

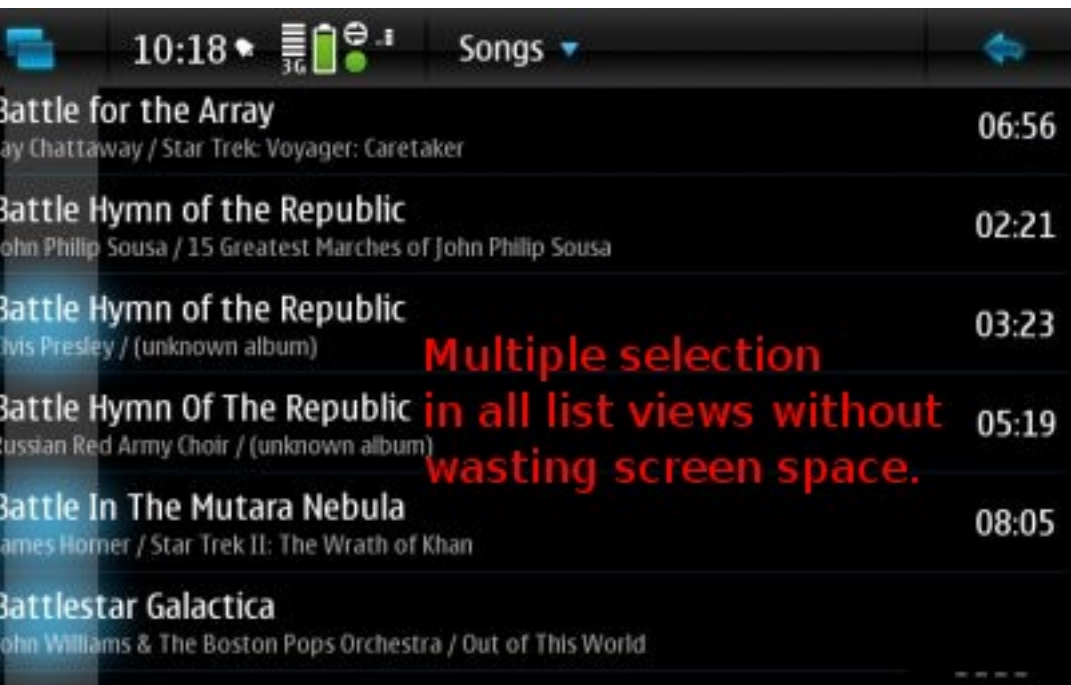

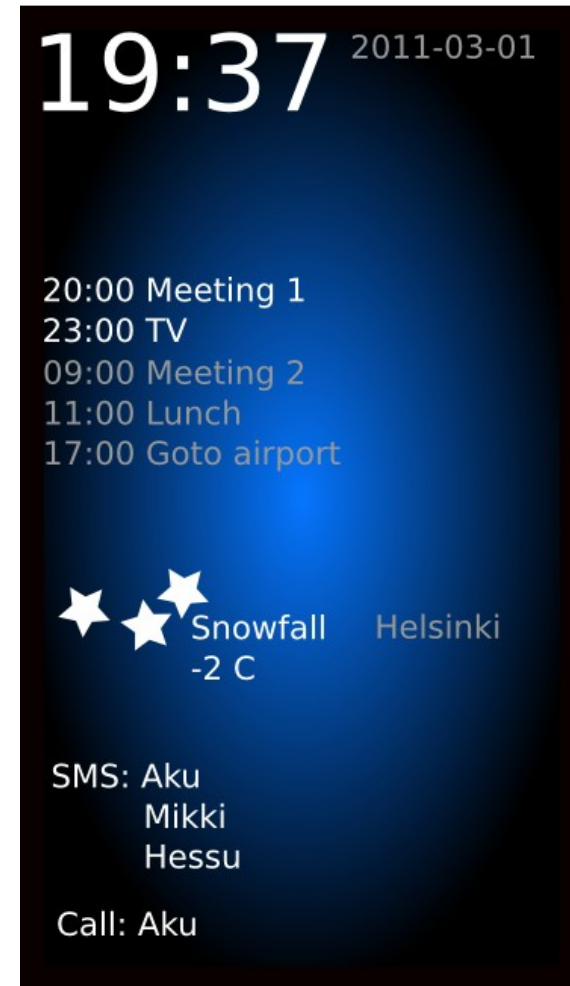


Local groups communicate faster

 - ...but Maemo and MeeGo had corporate support
- We need a better strategy
 - Tizen can eventually be part of it, if it earns it
 - In the meantime...

Use what we have!

- Did GNU sleep until Hurd was ready?
- Did KDE choose sides?
- We don't actually know who's going to win, and neither did they.

We're actually in a better position

- Why are we still focusing on the back end?
 - We shouldn't need a specific distro any more than Gnome needs Slackware
 - Who knows what the best option will be?
- Qt and QML are amazing, and KDE has a bunch of amazing code
- Qt can run on virtually anything
